- Induction, training and reimbursable expenses.

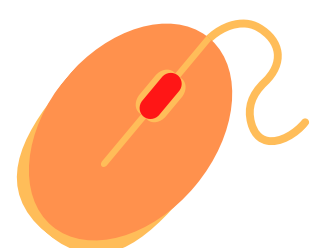


Expected time commitment: 1 hour per week plus 2-hour termly team meetings based in Thanet/online.
